GAME RULES

INTRODUCTION:

- Welcome, and thank you for your support of the Noyo Center for Marine Science and your
 participation in the Whale Festival Scavenger Hunt FUNdraiser. Despite the uncertainty about the
 community's Annual Whale Festival normally spearheaded by the Mendocino Coast Chamber of
 Commerce, the Noyo Center is offering its own Whale Festival activities for 2021.
- In addition to raising needed funds, we want you to have FUN and learn a little more about the magnificent Mendocino coast grey whales, migration, citizen science, and all we do at the Noyo Center for Marine Science.

RULES:

- Safety first! Please be aware of the weather and the tides. Familiarize yourself with "sneaker waves", never turn your back to the ocean, and remember the water is cold, and those rocks can be slippery.
- Breaking any local law or order disqualifies you from participating.
- Familiarize yourself with the Mendocino County Health Order.
- Do NOT disturb, remove or collect any live plants or animals.
- Participants do not have to complete the entire game to qualify for prizes. Points are awarded for any right answer or activity completed.
- Employees of the Noyo Center are welcome to play, but are not eligible for prizes.

GAME DATES:

- March 6 21, 2021
- Participants have 16 days to complete the scavenger hunt

SIGN UP:

- You must register and pay on-line at the Noyo Center's Scavenger Hunt Website.
- Individual players participate for \$25, teams play for \$100, and students are \$10.

- You may participate as a team of up to six people (children under 10 are free): \$100.
- Your team may be your immediate family, friends, and/or your colleagues from work. You can go out separately or as a group if you are a Stable Bubble as per county regulations.

All photos submitted must include a Noyo logo. Contained in your emailed game packet will be a
reporting card (with the Noyo logo and information on how to report a stranded marine mammal), as
well as a measuring tool to show the size of your items found. You are welcome to use this card or,
alternatively, wear a Noyo t-shirt, hat, water bottle, or brochure as the Noyo logo in your photo.
